

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### Virtual Taylor Winter Intensive

1. **How is the day structured?** Each day includes a Taylor technique, a Taylor repertory and a Dance on Camera class with two 30-minute breaks in between.
2. **What are the hours of the Intensive?** The Intensive runs from 12:00pm – 6:00pm (EST) with informal “virtual sharings” on the final day.
3. **How old do you have to be, and how old is too old?** Dancers from age 16 through professional may attend the New York Winter Intensive.
4. **I’m not in school. Who can write my evaluation?** Please have a mentor or a teacher with whom you take class often complete the Teacher Evaluation Form.
5. **Is there a dress code?** There is no dress code. Please wear clothes you will feel comfortable moving in that are appropriate for class and for being seen on a Zoom platform (i.e., clothes that are not too baggy, so that teachers can see body alignment).
6. **How many different Taylor dances will we learn?** You will learn excerpts/phrases from one or two Taylor pieces over the week.
7. **How many students are in each class?** Depending on enrollment, class size may range from about 20 to 30 dancers.
8. **Are there different levels? How are levels determined?** This year, there will only be one class. All students are included in the same class.
9. **Are there any breaks in the day? If so, how long will they be?** There are two 30 minute breaks each day between each of the three classes. There also may be 5-10 minute breaks during the Taylor Repertory and Dance on Camera classes.
10. **Zoom Guidelines**
  - The Zoom classroom will open 5 minutes before class begins. Please try not to be late as you may end up having to wait to be let into the class.
  - Please make sure Zoom cameras are on with NO virtual backgrounds.
  - Please make sure you have as safe and clear a space as possible to dance in.
  - Although we may need to mute you while the class is in session, we highly encourage teacher-student interaction and will unmute you as needed to facilitate dialogue.
  - To avoid technical issues/interruptions, please make sure your WiFi connection is strong, or that you are hard wired.
